Humane Society of Indianapolis Accepts Animals from Rushville Animal Shelter

INDIANAPOLIS...Martha M. Boden, CEO of the Humane Society of Indianapolis (HSI), called Rushville, Indiana Mayor Bob Bridges and offered to take that city's animals while the City of Rushville Animal Shelter is temporarily closed.

A total of sixteen dogs and ten cats were transferred to Indianapolis. One of dogs from Rushville has already been returned to its owner after HSI employees were able to locate the owner using the dog's rabies tag.

The Rushville animals are undergoing the same pre-adoption and adoption process as all other animals surrendered to HSI. Each animal will receive a medical evaluation and behavior assessment to ensure their suitability for adoption before being spayed or neutered, microchipped, and placed on the adoption floor.
