## “I’ve lost my pet. What do I do?”



- Check local shelters and humane societies.
- Indianapolis Animal Care and Control allows you to report your lost pet and view their strays. Contact ACC at 317-327-1397 for more information.
- Check with your vet and vets around the area your pet was lost. Ask if you may post flyers in their lobby.
- If you’ve lost your pet and your pet had a microchip, be sure you contact your pet’s microchip registry company to see if anyone has contacted them, and to verify they have the most up-to-date contact information for you.
- Publicize in the area you lost your pet. Post lost and found flyers in the area where your pet was lost.
- Publicize On The Internet: There are many websites local and national that are dedicated to help reunite lost pets with their owners.
